SUMMARY

The 5th Stakeholders' Workshop of the Project LIFE CONOPS was held in Bologna, Italy, on 16th-17th April 2018. The title of the Workshop was "Sustainable invasive mosquitoes management following the LIFE CONOPS initiative". In total around 120 persons attended the workshop. Representatives of the LIFE CONOPS project presented the project's results to a large audience where the most important EU sponsored projects dealing with vectors and vector borne diseases were also represented.

5th Stakeholder (Final) Workshop in Bologna, <u>Italy</u>

The 5th Stakeholders' Workshop of the Project LIFE CONOPS (LIFE12 ENV/GR/000466) was held in Bologna, Italy, on <u>16th-17th April 2018</u>.

The title of the Workshop was "Sustainable invasive mosquitoes management following the LIFE CONOPS initiative". The workshop was organized by the "Servizio Prevenzione collettiva e Sanità Pubblica Regione Emilia-Romagna", AUSL della Romagna and Centro Agricoltura Ambiente "G.Nicoli".

The main purpose of the 4th Stakeholder Workshop in Italy was to present the project results to the large audience of public health in Italy, while focusing on sustainable mosquito management.

Representatives of the LIFE CONOPS project presented the project's results to a large audience where the most important EU sponsored projects dealing with vectors and vector borne diseases were also represented.

More specifically, Luciano Toma and Marco Di Luca from the National Institute of Health in Italy, presented the status of the vector borne disease risk in Italy. Annita Vakali (KEELPNO, Greece) presented the status of the vector borne disease risk in Greece. Gregory L'Ambert from EID Littoral Méditerranéen (France) presented the French system in the management of *Aedes albopictus* borne diseases. Donatella Varrenti from PH AUSL Anzio (Italy) gave a speech on the management of the 2017 Chikungunya epidemic in Anzio. Roberto Cagarelli and Andrea Mattivi from PH Emilia-Romagna (Italy) focused on the results of the Emilia-Romagna regional surveillance system for vector borne diseases. Dr. Francis Schaffner from FS Consultancy (Switzerland) presented the outcomes of VectorNet 2015-2018. Anna-Bella Failloux from Institut Pasteur (France) gave a speech in the EU projects for the prevention of vector borne diseases. Igor Pajovic from the University of Montenegro presented the results of the LOVCEN project in Montenegro. Alessandro Albieri from CAA (Italy) gave a speech on preventing vectorial borne diseases throughout new tools supporting operational capacity.

In total around 120 persons attended the Workshop.

The website of LIFE CONOPS project became the information gate for stakeholders and the general public. The presentations of the workshop were uploaded to the website

in order to be available to all interested parties, that were unable to attend the workshop, and to those who would like to review the presentations of the guest speakers and listen to questions/ points raised by the participating stakeholders.
